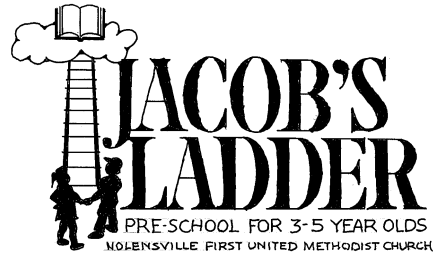
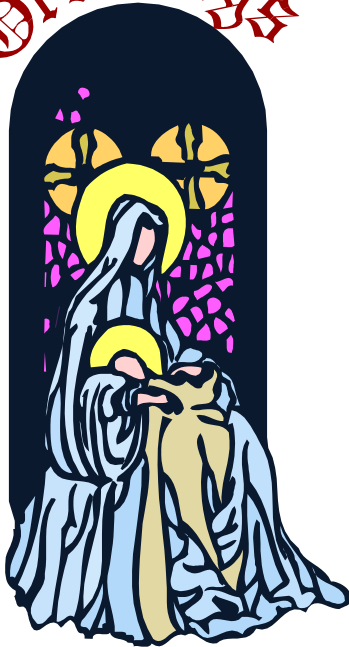


Greetings
